## Phase 3 CA MTSS Capacity-Building Grant for COEs

❖ \$50,000 per COE



- To build capacity for county office staff to provide coaching and technical assistance to LEAs and schools for CA MTSS
- Become a certified county office coach for CA MTSS using the CA MTSS Pathway Certification for Schools online course; estimated completion time between 50-60 hours
- Support LEA and school awardees as they utilize the certification course and implement the CA MTSS framework
- Engage in a continuous improvement process to create systemic change needed to improve outcomes for all learners
- Gather and submit applicable data

## Phase 3 CA MTSS Sub-Grant for School Sites and Consortia

- ❖ \$50,000 for schools with up to 1,000 students or
- ❖ \$100,000 for schools over 1,000 students
- ❖ Up to \$315,000 as a consortium



- Administrators will engage in coaching to support implementation of the CA MTSS Framework
- 90% of school staff will complete the CA MTSS Pathway Certification for Schools course within five years
- Implement the CA MTSS framework with fidelity at the school level with a focus on building or enhancing the social-emotional well being of youth using UDL, Trauma Informed Practices and CLRT practices
- Engage in a continuous improvement process to create systemic change needed to improve outcomes for all learners
- Gather and submit data, including, but not limited to: Fidelity Integrity Assessment (FIA), Schoolwide Implementation Tool (SIT), LEA Self Assessment (LEASA) and other data related to school conditions and climate
